After studying architecture in France and the United States, and working in Paris for twenty years, Marianne Pascal decided in 2008 to devote herself exclusively to her art.

She uses a wide range of media: drawing, sculpture, video, photography, writing and installation. The world of childhood, memories and dreams, and the metaphor of travel in time and space, are the inspiration for her works, which are constructed from materials she recovers and assembles in a fragile balance.

Her works are often animated and practicable, producing sound and light. Her videos combine sound and images of her works, nature and our contemporary world.
